OBJECTIVES

- Eliminating out-of-pocket expenses for families of pregnant women and sick infants, who seek care in government health facilities
- Timely access to care for sick infants including neonates

And thereby reduce MMR and IMR (specifically neonatal mortality)

Target Beneficiaries

- Pregnant Woman with complications during ANC period
- Cases of Normal Delivery
- Delivery and it's complications (**Episiotomy/CS/ Eclampsia, APH, PPH etc.**) arising **up to 6 weeks** during post partum period
- Sick newborns and Sick infants (Up to one year)

Scope: All public health facilities

Component-1

Free Transportation Services

Free Referral Transportation Services

JSSK mandate- Free transportation services must be made available.

1. **From Home to health facility (1st referral)**
2. **Between health facilities if required (2nd referral)**
3. **Drop back from facilities to home**

Targeted Beneficiaries

- High risk ANC Cases when referred for treatment
- All delivery cases
- PNC cases up to 42 days with complications
- Sick Infants (up to one year)

Provisions :

- For 1st referral- 108/102
- For 2nd referral- 108 to be called by facility
- For drop back a lump sum amount @Rs.500/- per case to be reimbursed along with JSY benefit through PFMS to account of the beneficiary who had stayed in facilities for at least 48 hours or above

Free Drugs & Consumables

Free Drugs & Consumables

- **For Normal Delivery cases**

- For Delivery and its complications (**Episiotomy/CS/ Eclampsia, APH, PPH etc.**)
- For Complications arising **up to 6 weeks** during post partum period
- For Sick newborns **till 30 days after birth** and Sick Infants **up to one year**

- Drugs and consumables will be provided to the beneficiaries free of cost in case of both indoor and outdoor services

- In case of emergency and shortage of drugs the facility will provide the drugs by procuring from the available funds (20% State Budget Funds under Drugs available at the district level)

- The district is responsible to procure the stock out drugs before it is out of stock

- Facility must submit its requirement well in the buffer period before stock out of the drug


Free Diagnostics Services

- All diagnosis are free of cost for all beneficiates at facility level under NIDAN mandate
- Funds provisioned in PIP- @ Rs.100/- per case X (nos. of estimated delivery + Sick Infants)
- Ultrasound is also free and available free of cost in all district empanelled private ultrasound clinic
- Facility is responsible to tag the beneficiary to the empanelled USG clinic
- Any other diagnostic required for the beneficiary if not available at facility then will be referred to higher public facility and will be covered by JSSK/BSKY

Provision of FREE BLOOD to the complicated delivery cases and Infants under “JSSK” means:

- Provision of Blood ---**Free of User Charges**
- Provision of Blood---- **Free of Mandatory Exchange Donation**

Provisions-

- Funds @ Rs.400/- per unit of blood under JSSK
- Monthly reimbursement to be done by facility to Blood Bank or BSU as per utilization. It is the responsibility of facility not of the beneficiary.

Component-5

Free Diet

- All delivery cases, Indoor ANC cases and Post delivery cases will get diet free of cost for the period of hospitalization
- For normal delivery – upto 3 days
- For CS- for 7 days
- However if the beneficiary stays for more days then also diet will be provided as per advice till she stays in hospital

No user to be collected from JSSK beneficiaries from

- OPD
- IPD (O&G and Pediatric)
- SNCU
- Diagnostic (Lab, Usg etc.)

Grievance Redressal

Centralized system – 104 toll free call center

Local system:

- Fixing of Complaint –cum- Suggestion Box at OPD(O&G + Pediatric OPD), Wards ,Labour Room & SNCU
- Fixed day collection- at least on every fortnight & register in a register.
- Discussion in SVS meeting for necessary action

Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY)

Janani Suraksha Yojana

- Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY) is a safe motherhood intervention in which both the women and the ASHAs are given cash assistance for ensuring a safe institutional delivery.
- This scheme is presently implemented in all government facilities and accredited private institutions..

- All mothers delivering at public health facility and private accredited facilities irrespective of age, birth order, or income group (BPL & APL) will get financial assistance in one go and ASHA will get the incentive for promoting the same. In case of home delivery the benefit will be given only of BPL cases.

Rs. 600/- per delivery for rural areas: Rs.300/- for antenatal component and Rs. 300/- for facilitating institutional delivery.

Rs. 400/- per delivery for urban areas: Rs.200/- for antenatal component and Rs. 200/- for facilitating institutional delivery.
